

## ERL Reaches Ipoh!

KLIA's Express Rail Link (ERL) has extended its reach beyond Kuala Lumpur. Travellers from Ipoh, the capital city of Perak state, can now purchase ERL tickets when they travel on the Keretapi Tanah Melayu (KTM) Electric Train Service (ETS). This new integrated connection was launched recently by Tan Sri Syed Hamid Albar, chairman of the Land Public Transport Commission (LPTC). Present at the launch were management teams from KTM and ERL as well as government officials and industry representatives. KTM President and Managing Director Dr. Aminuddin Adnan said that five ETS trains provide eight return trips for the Kuala Lumpur-Ipoh route daily. The first train will leave at 5am and the last at 11pm.

ERL Chief Executive Officer Noormah Mohd Noor said that the high-speed and low-carbon KLIA Ekspres train service takes passengers from KL Sentral to KLIA in just 28 minutes, and at 20-minute intervals from 5am till 1am daily. Customers can purchase tickets online. The e-tickets issued in PDF format are valid for use on the selected travel date only. With this e-ticket, passengers can go directly through the gates by just using the barcode printed on it.
